We will be developing our understanding of addition, subtraction and repeated addition. We will also be looking at o'clock and half past times and the fraction of one half.

Computing

We will be using beebots and following and creating algorithms. We will also be using technology to create digital content.

Art and Design

We will be exploring colour, pattern, texture, line and shape to create pictures and sculptures. We will be learning about a range of artists and describing similarities and differences between their work.

Geography

We will be using maps, atlases and globes to identify the world's seven continents and five oceans. We will also be developing our geographic vocabulary to refer to key physical and human features.
