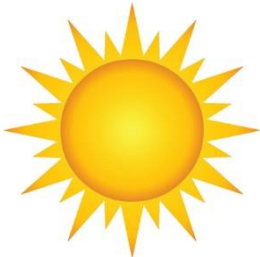
Dear Parents/Carers,

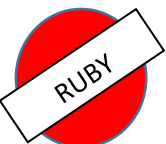
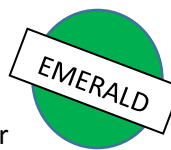
## Summer is here at last!
